Elefun Ball Popper

This toy encourages in and out play by grabbing balls from the elephant's tummy and dropping them in the elephant's ears. When a child drops balls into the toy, the balls pop out in a different place, building cause/effect skills. The toy's design also encourages young children to reach and catch.



Go Talk 4+

The GoTalk4+ includes 4 recordable messages, 5 recording levels and large message keys (4X4") for easy access. Two additional core messages remain constant on all levels. It can be used to build vocabulary, initiate conversations, and participate in daily activities. (multi-message, multi-level, recordable) Also see Go Talk 9+.

Create animal, food, and location choices when going to the zoo.



Peek-a-boo Bear

Switch-activated bear will play peekaboo when the switch is pressed. Ideal for basic cause and effect and interactive play. A switch appropriate for the child must be requested as well.



Monkey Balance Board

The Monkey Balance Board is designed to encourage physical activity by improving balance, coordination, and leg strength. To use it, kids can stand with one foot on either side of the board. Put one foot on the board before carefully adding the other and attempting to balance by shifting your weight from side to side.



Sensory Pal (Frog)

Sound or movement sets Mr. Frog (13"x16") going. These vibrating animals help develop cause and effect, vocalization and interaction, while providing sensory input.

Mr. Frog could be used to provide concrete, tactile input to a child listening to a story involving a frog, or to provide sensory support for self-regulation, or to target cause-and-effect.



Dress-up Bear Puzzle

The Wooden Bear Family Dress-Up Puzzle includes 45 sturdy, colorful mix-and-match pieces to spark imaginative play. Designed for preschool, this puzzle comes with a range of facial expressions and plenty of clothes to put together to create Mama, Papa, and Baby Bear characters. Puzzle pieces can be
