


Let's Participate! 'Safety First' Theme

	<p>Pool Noodles</p> <p>Pool Noodles can be cut and used to buffer sharp edges, used to divide spaces or make a personal space “bubble” visual and tactile, and many more things! We have some available for adapting items in your classrooms--just let us know and we can bring some by!</p>
	<p>GoTalk One</p> <p>A single message talker with a large picture display and a large play button. Up to 6 available in library.</p> <p><i>You can use these to reinforce labels, to have a child with communication delays contribute answers to a planned lesson, etc.</i></p>
	<p>Daily Schedule Chart</p> <p>Give children an at-a-glance view of the day's events and activities with this daily schedule pocket chart! All-Turn-It® Spinner

Pressing the button on the battery operated All-Turn-It spinner enables random selections for choosing groups or playing games of chance like bingo. The spinner includes a built-in external switch jack for single switch use. The spinner has the option for customizable overlays (a dry-erase one is included, one could also trace it and make a version with photos of street signs and/or safety sight words).

Children can spin to select the next topic of discussion, to give classmates safety-related instructions, etc.




Walking Rope

This walking rope is a great tool to help keep children together and safe on field trips, or transitioning to other spaces. Made of sturdy nylon webbing, the rope has 12 colorful handles for children to hold in addition to front and back handles for teachers to share with a child. (146" long)



Crazy Cutter

Comfortable "mouse" shaped cutting device utilizes new ceramic technology and does not cut skin. Since paper is cut while flat on table it only needs to be stabilized and not grasped. This will make cutting an easier and more successful task for many children.



ezpz Happy Mat

One-piece placemat + plate helps to make mealtimes less stressful. The placemat suctions to the table to reduce tipped bowls/plates. May be useful for a child who is working on self-feeding as the bowl is unable to slide away.

This can contribute to mealtime safety by reducing spills or increasing independent access to food.



Utensil Holder

This simple, adjustable utensil holder comes with a holding pocket that accommodates most utensil handles. It adjusts quickly and easily on any size hand with Velcro fasteners to provide independent feeding.



Gripables Comfortable Cutlery

This silverware makes self-feeding easier with a comfortable, sensory handle - with raised rings - that allows for easier gripping.
